



Ochil Shawl

WCY-104



4mm needles (80cm circular recommended)

21 sts per 4"/10cm in stocking stitch on 4mm needles (unblocked)

Yarn: 4ply/fingering – 250m of main colour, 100m of contrast 1, 50m of contrast 2, 3, 4

Block to 60" wingspan, 22.5" depth

Shown in 1 ball of JC Rennie Lambswool Cashmere 4ply Cronus, 2 JC Rennie Miniballs of Medium grey and one Miniball each of Silver, Iris and Confetti.

This pattern uses all of the main colour, and a bit over one miniball of Contrast 1, but there is plenty left of the other shades. If you want to finish the shawl a bit early to be sure of having enough yarn (the cast off takes about 5g) then you can do the alternative stripe sequence which can be finished after only two stripes without disrupting the symmetry. You can also start the garter stitch edging straight after the final contrast stripe on row 114.

If you are not comfortable with the garter stitch tab then you can just cast on 11 sts and proceed with row 1. The garter stitch tab gives a neat, uninterrupted top edge that continues into the 4 st garter stitch border worked integrally throughout.

The stitch count increases by 4 stitches on every right side row and 2 stitches every wrong side row.

Garter Stitch Tab

In main colour cast on 4 sts. Knit 6 rows.

Pick up and knit 3 sts from side of square, 4 sts along cast on edge. Total 11 sts

Row 1: WS: K4, YO, P to last 4 sts, YO, K4
13sts

Row 2: RS: K4, YO, K2, YO, PM, K1, PM, YO,
K2, YO, K4 17sts

Row 3: K4, YO, P to last 4 sts, YO, K4 19 sts

Row 4: K4, YO, K to marker, YO, SM, K1, SM,
YO, Knit to last 4 sts, YO, K4 23 sts

Row 5: As Row 3 25 sts

Rows 6-9 - Repeat Rows 4&5 twice 37 sts

Rows 10 – 13, Change to Contrast 1:

Repeat rows 4&5 twice 49 sts

Rows 14-15, Change to Main C: Repeat
rows 4&5 once 55 sts

Rows 16-19, Change to Contrast 2, Repeat
rows 4&5 twice 67 sts

Rows 20-21, Change to Main C: Repeat
rows 4&5 once 73 sts

Rows 22-25, Change to Contrast 1: Repeat
rows 4&5 twice 85 sts

Rows 26-27, Change to Main C: Repeat
rows 4&5 once 91 sts

Row 28: K4, YO, K1, (YO, K2tog) to marker,
YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, (SSK, YO) to last 5 sts,
K1, Yo, K4 95 sts

Row 29: K4, YO, K to marker, SM, P1, SM, K
to last 4 sts, YO, K4 97 sts

Row 30: K4, YO, K2, (YO, K2tog) to marker,
YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, (SSK, YO) to last 6 sts,
K2, YO, K4 101 sts

Row 31: As row 29 103 sts

Rows 32-39: Repeat last 4 rows twice more
127 sts

Row 40-43: Repeat Rows 4&5 twice 139 sts

Row 44: Change to Contrast 3 K4, YO, K3,
[slip 2, K6] to 6 sts before marker, Slip 2, K4,
YO, SM, K1, SM, YO, K4, Slip 2, [K6, slip 2] to
last 7 sts, K3, YO, K4 143 sts

Row 45: K4, YO, Purl contrast sts, slip main
colour sts to last 4 sts, YO, K4 145 sts

Row 46: K4,YO, K5, [slip 2, K6] to 7 sts before marker, Slip 2, K5,YO, SM, K1, SM,YO, K5, Slip 2, [K6, slip 2] to last 9 sts, K5,YO, K4 149 sts

Row 47: as row 45 151 sts

Row 48-49 change to Main C, Repeat rows 4&5 once 157 sts

Row 50: Change to Contrast 4, K4,YO, K5, [slip 2, K6] to 5 sts before marker, Slip 2, K3, YO, SM, K1, SM,YO, K3, Slip 2, [K6, slip 2] to last 9 sts, K5,YO, K4 161 sts

Row 51:As row 45 163 sts

Row 52: K4,YO, K7, [slip 2, K6] to 6 sts before marker, Slip 2, K4,YO, SM, K1, SM,YO, K4, Slip 2, [K6, slip 2] to last 11 sts, K7,YO, K4 167 sts

Row 53:As row 45 169 sts

Row 54-57: change to Main C, Repeat rows 4&5 twice. 181 sts

Row 58:As row 30 185 sts

Row 59:As row 29 187 sts

Row 60:As row 28 191 sts

Row 61:As row 29 193 sts

Row 62-65: Repeat rows 58-61 once more 205 sts

Row 66-69: Repeat rows 4&5 twice. 217 sts

Row 70: Change to contrast 4, K4,YO, K3, [slip 2, K6] to 5 sts before marker, Slip 2, K3, YO, SM, K1, SM,YO, K3, Slip 2, [K6, slip 2] to last 7 sts, K3,YO, K4 221 sts

Row 71:As row 45 223 sts

Row 72: K4,YO, K5, [slip 2, K6] to 6 sts before marker, Slip 2, K4,YO, SM, K1, SM,YO, K4, Slip 2, [K6, slip 2] to last 9 sts, K5,YO, K4 227 sts

Row 73:As row 45 229 sts

Row 74-75: change to Main C, Repeat rows

4&5 once 235 sts

Row 76: Change to contrast 3, K4,YO, K5, [slip 2, K6] to 4 sts before marker, Slip 2, K2, YO, SM, K1, SM,YO, K2, Slip 2, [K6, slip 2] to last 9 sts, K5,YO, K4 239 sts

Row 77:As row 45 241 sts

Row 78: K4,YO, K7, [slip 2, K6] to 5 sts before marker, Slip 2, K3,YO, SM, K1, SM,YO, K3, Slip 2, [K6, slip 2] to last 11 sts, K7,YO, K4 245 sts

Row 79:As row 45 247 sts

Rows 80-83: change to Main C, Repeat rows 4&5 twice 259 sts

Row 84-95: as rows 28-39 295 sts

Row 96-97 Repeat rows 4&5 twice 301 sts

Rows 98-115 as rows 10-27 355 sts

Row 116: as row 4 359 sts

Row 117-120: Knit all sts 359 sts

Cast off all stitches using a stretchy cast off, such as the decrease cast off: K2, * insert the left hand needle back into these 2 sts on the right hand needle, K2togtbl, K1, repeat from * until all stitches are cast off.

Weave in ends and wet block to measurements.

Alternative stripe sequence

Rows 1-9 Main colour

Rows 10-11, Contrast 1

Rows 12-13, Contrast 2

Rows 14-15, Main colour

Rows 16-27: Repeat rows 10-15 twice.

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Rows 98-115: Repeat rows 10-15 three times.

Abbreviations

K – Knit

P – Purl

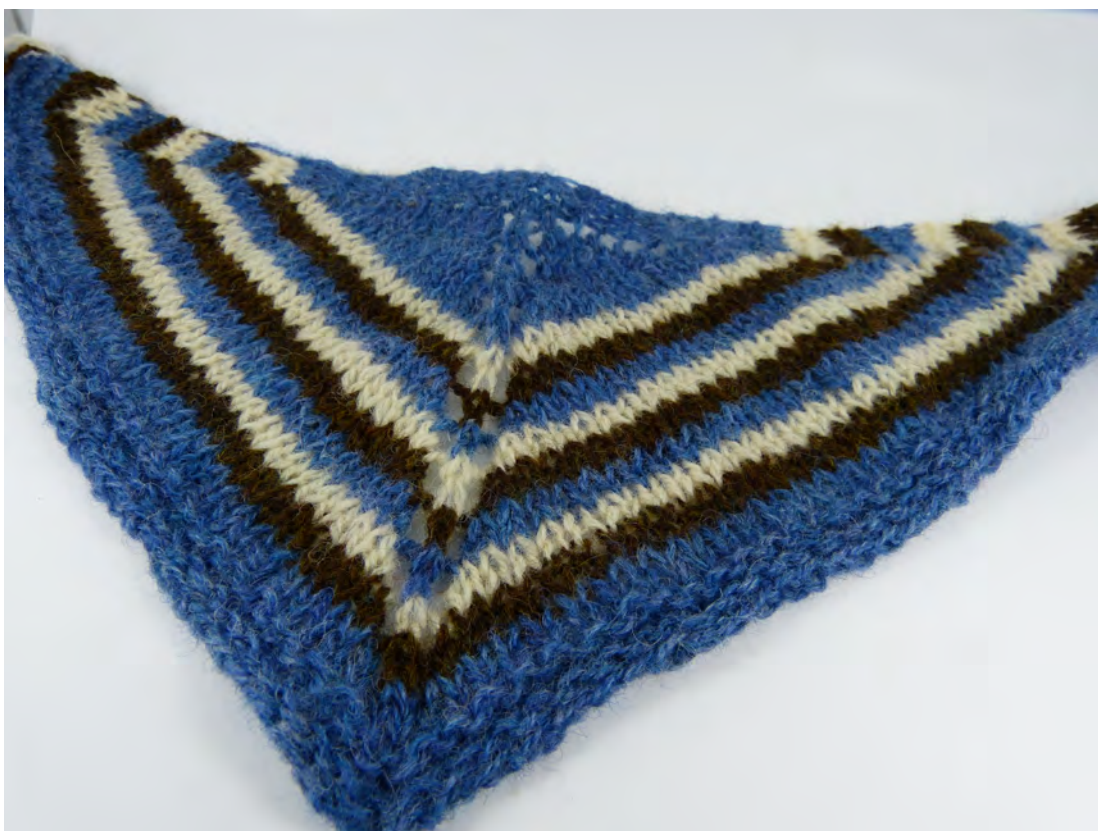
YO – Yarn over

sts – Stitches

PM – Place marker

SM – Slip marker

C - Colour



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
