



**Yarn:**

1 x 50g hank Kinross 4ply - 205m of fingering weight yarn.

**Needles and notions:**

3.25mm 40cm circular needles plus longer circular or DPNs for crown, 3mm is recommended for the baby size.

Stitch marker

Darning needle

Cable needle (optional)

**Size:** To fit Adult 23" (Small adult 21", child 19", baby 17") - Finished size 18" (16", 14", 12") unstretched.

**Tension:** 28 sts per 10cm in stocking stitch

A slouchy twisted ribbed hat with single stitch cables that you can make either with or without a cable needle. If you prefer a snugger beanie you can start the decreases after the main pattern. The largest size uses a single hank of Kinross 4ply.

**Abbreviations:**

K - Knit

P - Purl

Sts - Stitches

PM - Place marker

tbl - through back of loop

C2Ftbl - Cable two forward: with the cable

needle - slip next st onto cable needle and hold to front of work. K1, then K1tbl from cable needle. Without cable needle - taking RH needle round behind the first st, K the second st tbl, then K the first st tbl and slip both sts off the LH needle.

K2tog - Knit two stitches together

## Cast on

Using your preferred method, cast on 126 (112, 98, 84) sts. PM and join in round, being careful not to twist the stitches.

Rib round: (K1tbl, P1) to end

Repeat this round 15 (15, 15, 10) times, or until work measures approximately 2"/5cm (2"/5cm, 2"/5cm, 1.25"/3cm)

- 8: [K4, K1tbl, P1, (K1tbl, P1)x4] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 9: [K4, C2Ftbl, (K1tbl, P1)x4] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 10: [K5, K1tbl, (K1tbl, P1)x4] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 11: [K5, C2Ftbl, P1, (K1tbl, P1)x3] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 12: [K6, K1tbl, P1, (K1tbl, P1)x3] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 13: [K6, C2Ftbl, (K1tbl, P1)x3] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 14: [K7, K1tbl, (K1tbl, P1)x3] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 15: [K7, C2Ftbl, P1, (K1tbl, P1)x2] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 16: [K8, K1tbl, P1, (K1tbl, P1)x2] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 17: [K8, C2Ftbl, (K1tbl, P1)x2] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 18: [K9, K1tbl, (K1tbl, P1)x2] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 19: [K9, C2Ftbl, P1, K1tbl, P1] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 20: [K10, K1tbl, P1, K1tbl, P1] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 21: [K10, C2Ftbl, K1tbl, P1] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 22: [K11, K1tbl, K1tbl, P1] x9 (8, 7, 6)

- 23: [K11, C2Ftbl, P1] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 24: [K12, K1tbl, P1] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 25: [K12, C2Ftbl] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 26: [K13, K1tbl] x9 (8, 7, 6)
- 27: K

Work in stocking stitch until hat measures 7.5"/19cm (7"/18cm, 6.5"/16.5cm, 5.5"/14cm) or desired length.

Decrease for crown, switching to magic loop or DPNs where necessary:

- 1: [K12, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 117/104/91/78sts
- 2: K
- 3: [K11, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 108/96/84/72sts
- 4: K
- 5: [K10, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 99/88/77/66sts
- 6: K
- 7: [K9, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 90/80/70/60sts
- 8: K
- 9: [K8, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 81/72/63/54sts
- 10: K
- 11: [K7, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 72/64/56/48sts
- 12: [K6, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 63/56/49/42sts
- 13: [K5, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 54/48/42/36sts
- 14: [K4, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 45/40/35/30sts
- 15: [K3, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 36/32/28/24sts
- 16: [K2, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 27/24/21/18sts
- 17: [K1, K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 18/16/14/12sts
- 18: [K2tog] x9 (8, 7, 6) 9/8/7/6sts

Break off yarn and thread through remaining sts and draw up. Weave in ends and wash.
